**ELLICOTTVILLE BREWING COMPANY
CHERRY WHEAT**

Sweet, dark, cherry ale, balanced and natural with a lovely aroma. A light touch of tartness is followed by hints of vanilla and a crisp, smooth finish. 5% ABV

March

**HAMBURG BREWING COMPANY
IRISH RED**

A smooth malty ale backed by a good dusting of roasted barley, just like the ones across the pond. 4.8% ABV

April

**BUFFALO OLDE BREWERY
LOVEJOY LAGER**

Helles lager made with locally sourced WNY malt and hops. Light, clean, crisp beer flavored beer. 4.8% ABV

May

**BIG DITCH BREWING COMPANY
BELGIAN STYLE WHEAT**

Belgian-style ale. Brewed with wheat, oats, orange zest and coriander. 5.5% ABV

June

**42 NORTH BREWING COMPANY
SOLSHINE SUMMER ALE**

Bright, crisp lager with a hint of citrus. Brewed with sweet orange peel, and a secondary fermentation with real tangerine. A true compliment to the sunny days and warm nights of a Western New York summer. 4.5% ABV

WEST COAST IPA**

Sticky Trees offers craft beer drinkers a well-balanced IPA with a moderate ABV and low IBU. We brew this IPA with Mosaic hops and malts typical of an IPA. The flavor is inspired by the variety of flavors a brewer can extract from Mosaic hops. 6.5% ABV
